We kindly inform you that the first exam session for the ADDITIONAL LEARNING REQUIREMENTS is planned on **Thursday 23 April 2026 at 3.00 pm CEST**.

Unless otherwise stated, the following dates and times are scheduled:

2nd sitting: **Thursday 28 May 2026 at 3.00 pm CEST**

3rd sitting: **Thursday 10 September 2026 at 3.00 pm CEST**

Please find below and in attachment further information on how to take the exam. Don't hesitate to contact this email address in case you need further clarifications.

Please read carefully further details about the Additional Learning Requirement Tests for the Academic Year 2025/2026, divided into the following groups:

- General Knowledge and Logical Thinking (10 questions in 30 minutes)
- MEQ0093143
- Physics and Mathematics (10 questions in 30 minutes) - MEQ0093142

The Additional Learning Requirements will be fulfilled with a passing score of 60% (6/10 correct questions) for each subject group, with 1 point for correct answers and 0 points for wrong or blank answers.

The test will take place on Moodle Exams, here follows the direct link: <https://esami.unipd.it/course/index.php?categoryid=382>.

Please make sure you access the link with your SSO and to have installed on your PC or laptop more than one browser to ensure Moodle functioning. Updated version of Google Chrome and Mozilla Firefox should suffice.

Once you have logged in to the Moodle space above, make sure to book all subjects for which you have to take the test. Booking procedures will be available through your Uniweb on exam sessions starting April 3rd, 2026 and not later than April 20th, 2026. For example: if you have ALR for General Knowledge and Logical Thinking and Physics and Mathematics, you have to book both tests during that time frame. You can verify what subjects you may have to book referring to what has been uploaded on your booklet in Uniweb by the Students' Career Office.

The tests will be available starting from Thursday 23 April 2026 at 3.00 pm CEST. You are required to access the following Zoom meeting on your smartphone or another device (not on the laptop or PC you will use to complete the quiz on Moodle) with your SSO account at least 30 min before the beginning of the test.



Students will be admitted from the Zoom waiting room, starting from 2:30 CEST.

Students will be admitted one by one for identification. After being admitted by the host from the waiting room, students will show their ID.



For surveillance purposes, students must access the Zoom meeting using a device such as a smartphone or a tablet, ensuring enough battery is available during the whole test. Please access the Zoom meeting after login with your SSO. The smartphone webcam must show the student so that one can see the area around the student and the computer screen, like in the image below. A pen and a blank sheet of paper are allowed during the test.

How to prepare the room:



- Choose a quiet and well-lit room in your home (study, kitchen, bedroom, etc.).
- Position your laptop and mobile device so as to avoid reflections and glare, with the light source (natural or artificial) preferably coming from the right or left.
- Place a support (bookcase, shelf, tripod, etc.) behind you on which, only when requested by the Additional Learning Requirements Committee, you will place your mobile device with the camera facing your desk. The support must have:
 - an angle of approximately 45° to the desk
 - a maximum height of 1.50 metres from the floor
 - a distance of approximately 1.50 metres from the desk

During the tests:



- The mobile device and laptop must be connected to a power source.
- The door to the room must be closed and must be visible in the frame of the mobile device.
- You may not use any other type of device or accessories such as headphones, earphones or external microphones.
- You must sit centrally in front of the laptop screen.
- You must wear clothing that does not allow you to hide objects (such as sweatshirts with pockets, jackets, coats).
- Only your laptop, blank sheets of paper, a pen and your ID document may be on your desk. You must remove any other objects or tools other than those listed above.
- You must have your mobile device with you to connect to ZOOM to access the virtual classroom; the mobile device must be placed on the stand behind you only when instructed to do so by the examination board.

Dear All,

in order to help you with your Additional Learning Requirements (you have to pass them before enrolling to the official exam session and not later than September 30th, 2026), the Medicine and Surgery Degree Course bought an online platform: this platform will give you the possibility to get some exercises and prepare for the final exam.

In attachment I'll give each of you a personal code to enter the platform and start practicing. Check your matriculation number/student ID to see your personal code.

Here you have the instructions:

Go to the link http://www.edises.it/attivita/ofa_2025_pd_en/

Click on "Scarica Ebook"

Insert your personal code and click on "Continua"

Since you are a new user, you have to register at the website. If you already have an account on the website, you can use your credentials (email and password) to log in by clicking on "Accedi".

As soon as you get the login, you'll be redirected to the page "I miei ebook", where you could download your ebook. Once you have clicked on "download" you'll be redirected on the e-book reader VitalSource. At this point you can choose between two options: 1. Register yourself to the reading platform → in this way you can download your text on your device (two mobile devices and two PC for each user) or 2. Select the "No, thanks. I'll skip this step" → By doing this you'll be able to only visualize your text online.

Once the ebook is open, you can easily navigate through the text using the menu in the upper-left side of the page.
